Reception Maple class den day

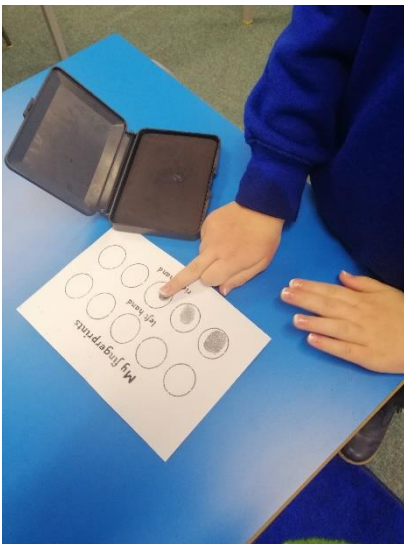
