- through your employer if they offer testing to employees
- at a local test site
- by collecting a home test kit from a test site
- by ordering a home test kit online

Our local test site is St Mary's church hall. Members of the public can now book a Covid lateral flow test through Hillingdon's web site, even if they have no symptoms.
