Dear Reception Parents and Carers,

We are writing to provide you with some useful information to support your child's transition from reception to Year 1.

The first half term in Year 1 will be a transition period, where we will still have lots of opportunities to learn through play as we ease the children into Key Stage One.

There will be a 'meet the teacher' meeting on Tuesday the 7<sup>th</sup> September at 9.15am in the school hall after you have dropped your child off to class. This will be a short meeting where you will get to; meet the teachers, learn a little about the expectations for Year One and what your child will learn throughout the year. We hope you can make this meeting but understand if you cannot and will email relevant information to parents following the meeting. We will also still send home termly curriculum letters, informing you of what your child will be learning in school.

### **Uniform**

In year one children should wear:

Black shoes

Black, grey or white socks or tights

Black or grey trousers, shorts or skirt/pinafore (knee length) or blue and white summer dress (knee length)

White polo shirt or white blouse

Royal blue sweatshirt, cardigan or fleece

### **PE**

For PE children should come into school dressed in their PE uniforms:

Black shorts or jogging bottoms

White t-shirt

Plain black trainers or black plimsolls

White socks.

PE days will be confirmed in September.

### **What they need**

Just like in Reception your child will need:

A named book bag

A named water bottle

A named lunch box (if they are having packed lunch)

All other equipment will be provided by school.

### **Homework**

Weekly Maths and English homework is sent out on Monday's, completed homework should be emailed to the class teacher by the end of the week.

Reading books can be changed when read, parents should comment and sign their child's reading records. Children should be doing at least 10 minutes reading with an adult each day.

Children should access Mathletics and BugClub weekly.
