Nursery Applications September 2022

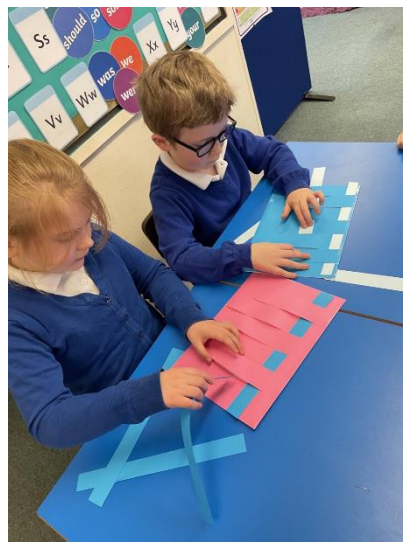
