## 'Travel Back in Time' Day

Dear Parents/Carers,

To celebrate the learning that has taken place this half term in History lessons, we have planned a **'Travel Back in Time' Day** on **Thursday 10<sup>th</sup> February 2022**.

The Junior school hall will be transformed into 'Harefield History Museum' where children from years 1 to 6 will be sharing what they have been learning about. Throughout the day, each of the year 1 to 6 classes will visit the 'museum' to find out about the different history topics everyone has been studying. We would also like to invite parents in to the 'museum' in the Junior school hall at **9am** on **Thursday 10<sup>th</sup> February** to see some of the fantastic learning that has taken place across both schools.

As well as the 'Harefield History Museum' in the Junior school hall, it will be a non-uniform day, where we would like children to come in to school dressed up in costumes linked to their current History topic. The children will be making props to accompany their costumes in class, linked to their learning (please speak to your child's class teacher for more details). Some key information is included below:

### Year 1: The Greatest Explorers

Children will be dressing up as explorers from either past or present, creating compasses and binoculars.



### Year 2: Our Local Heroes

Children will be dressing up as scientists linked to historical medical heroes such as Alexander Fleming and Florence Nightingale.

### Year 3: The Bronze Age and The Iron Age

Children will be dressing up as members of the Bronze Age, creating a Bronze Age axe.



### Year 4: Roman Britain

Children will be dressing up as Roman soldiers, creating scutum shields as part of their costume.



### Year 5: The Vikings

Children will be dressing up as Viking warriors, creating Viking shields as part of their costume.

### Year 6: The Ancient Greeks

Children will be dressing up in himations (togas) as Greek men and women, creating olive wreath headbands to accompany their costumes.



We look forward to welcoming you to **'Travel Back in Time' Day** and hope you will enjoy learning about the different topics as much as the children have.
