As part of our World Book Day celebrations, Reception, Year 1 and Year 2 classes visited the local library.

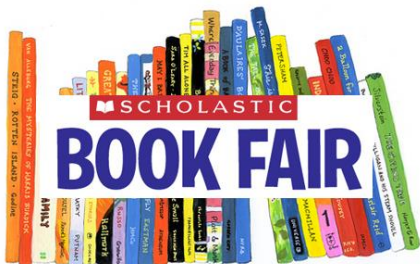


Reading buddies
