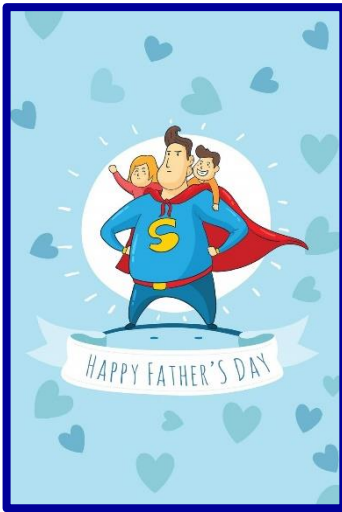
Well done to all of the pupils in **Red** house for earning more house points than the other houses this week.
