We have had a wonderful week this week, the children are always so engaged and eager to learn and have fully immersed themselves in the story of 'Were going on a bear hunt' and all of the activities we have set up for them around the nursery. This week we have been;

- Learning information about bears and making bubble maps of what we know.
- Singing there were 10 in the bed.
- Learning to give encouragement and support to our friends as they carry out a task in nursery by saying 'well done' or giving them a compliment.
- Comparing heavier, lighter and the same using weighing scales and a range of different items including a feather, an apple a pine cone.
- Drawing our favourite bears and writing some information we have learnt about them.
- Having lots of fun in our new sand pit outside and exploring capacity, full, half full, empty.



We went to the hall this week to act out the story of 'Were going on a bear hunt'. The children all really enjoyed moving their bodies in a range of different ways including skipping, spinning around, tiptoeing and stamping!

You can help your child to continue their learning at home by:

- Practising to write their name.
- Teaching them to do up their zip or their buttons on their coat.
- Asking them to sing you our new song of the week 'There were 10 in the bed'.
- Ask your child to tell you some of the interesting facts they have learnt about bears and see if you can find out some more by going to the library to find a book about bears or looking on the internet.
