Dear parents and carers,

What a fantastic week we have had in Nursery this week. We definitely have some budding scientists in our midst! The children have really embraced the theme of science week and have got stuck in with all of the experiments, making predictions about what they think will happen and sharing in pure delight with each other as they observed colours changing and volcanos erupting!

Here are some of the exciting experiments we have carried out this week:

- The wax crayon experiment, the children observed how the wax crayons melted when hot air was blown onto them from a hairdryer.
- Sinking and floating, making predictions and observing which objects sink and float.
- Colour mixing, what happens when we mix two primary colours together? The children loved creating new colours.
- The skittles experiment, what happens when you put skittles around a plate and add hot water to them?
- Making rainbows using kitchen roll, felt tip pens and cups of water.
- Planting seeds and learning all about the lifecycle of a plant.
- The volcano experiment using flour, baking powder and vinegar.
- Observing bananas as they change and decay over the space of a week.
