

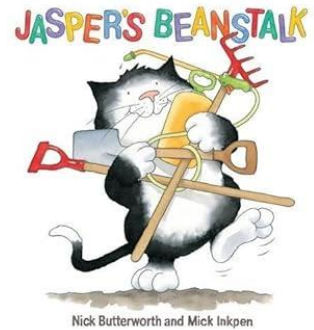
Friday 10th May 2024
