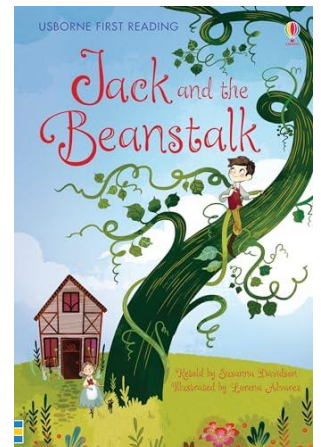


Friday 17th May 2024

Dear parents and carers,

We have continued our growing theme this week with the story of 'Jack and the Beanstalk'. The children have absolutely loved reading this book and have particularly enjoy being the Giant and shouting "Fee Fi Fo Fum". We have been using story wands to answer questions about the story such as 'who are the characters in the story? What happens at the end? What was your favourite part? The children have engaged in a range of activities including;

- Making their own beanstalks, which lead to a castle in the clouds.
- Painting characters from the story.
- Continuing to make repeating patterns.
- Measuring a giant's foot and building a tower, which is the same size.
- Buying and selling plants and flowers in the nursery garden centre.
- Continuing to learn our new letter sounds in Read, Write, Inc phonics.
- Practicing for sports day.



You can help your child to continue their learning at home by:

- Asking them to tell you the story of 'Jack and the Beanstalk'.
- Asking them questions about stories as you read with them.
- Completing this week's homework with them.
