Dear parents and carers,

The children have been learning the story of 'The Three Billy Goat's Gruff' in nursery this week. They have all enjoyed joining in with the new story and particularly like saying 'trip, trap, trip, trap' as they cross the bridge. There have been a few changes to the nursery over the half term break including the addition of a hair and beauty parlour. Everyone (including the teachers) has spent time having their haircut and styled, as well as undergoing an array of beauty treatments in there!

To support their learning this week the children have been;

- Painting billy goats and trolls.
- Learning the language big, medium and small to describe the goats.
- Building bridges and learning about bridges around the world.
- Making 'Wanted' posters for the troll who lives under the bridge in the story.
- Re-enacting the story of 'The Three Billy Goats Gruff'.
- Learning the tricky word 'the'.
- Learning about their bodies with Jigsaw Jenie, labelling body parts and internal organs and talking about what they do.

The children are going to be learning 'tricky words' this half term. Tricky words are words that cannot be read by sounding out each letter.
