Dear parents and carers,

We have had a fabulous week in nursery this week. The children have all been really engaged in the learning and have enjoyed many new experiences. We have been reading the story of 'The Three Little Wolves and the Big Bad Pig' and have been making comparisons between the story of 'The Three Little Pigs'. Looking at how the stories are different and what similarities they have. We have also been continuing to learn about growth with Jigsaw Jenie, The children loved sharing their photographs of when they were babies and toddlers and comparing them with how they look now. They could talk in detail about the differences between a baby and a child and explored the fact that they will one day become adults! To support their learning and development this week we have;

- Made bubble paintings, we had to blow through the straw using our strong breath just like the big bad pig.
- Been playing tennis in the garden just like 'The Three Little Wolves' in the story.
- Making tea in the water outside to go into the wolves china teapot.
- Been cleaning the bikes and scooters at the nursery car wash.
- Creating houses using the materials from the story.
- Learning information about Wolves.
- Learning to read the tricky words the, I and no.
- Used clay to create models, exploring the fact that it is stronger than playdough.
- Explored forces using sand and sand wheels, air tubes and bubbles.
- Built a giant marble run in the garden which we poured water down to push the balls along.
- Continued to learn the names of and explore 3d shapes.
