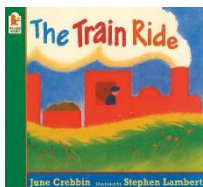
Dear parents and carers,

It has been a busy and hot week in nursery this week! The children have all managed to stay focused and engaged and have taken part in plentiful learning based around our latest story 'Goldilocks and the Three Bears'. To support their learning and development this week we have;

- Tasted porridge with a choice of sugar, honey or jam on top.
- Answered questions from the story using the story wands.
- Joined in with the story using a big voice for daddy bear, a medium voice for mummy bear and a tiny voice for baby bear.
- Learnt the song 'When Goldilocks went to the house of the bears'.
- Experimented filling different sized containers with porridge oats and compared the weight of them.
- Acted out the story using story props.
- Continued to learn our tricky words, we now know I, the, to and no.
- Painted the clay models we made last week.
- Continued to learn the names of and explore 3d shapes.

You can help your child to continue their learning at home by:

- Reading their phonics reading book with them.
- Playing eye spy with them, this is a great way to practice their phonics and make it fun!
- Giving your child different sized containers (Large, medium and small) to play with in the bath and experiment with filling and emptying them.
