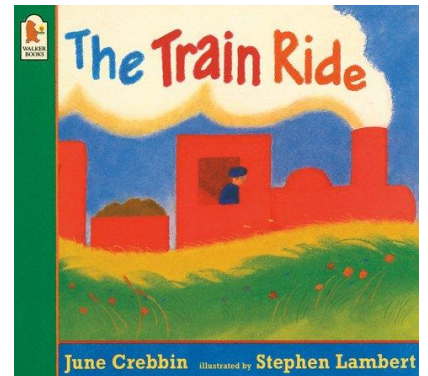


Friday 5th July 2024
