- Learning about Remembrance Day and why it is an important day in our country.



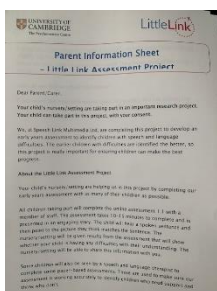
