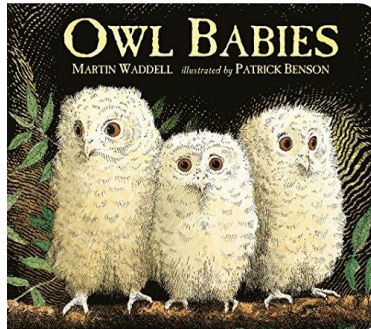

Dear Parents and carers,

We have continued our learning all about Owls this week. The children have been very busy;

- Acting out the story of owl babies using puppets.
- Making playdough owls.
- Making baby owl pictures using cotton wool.

- Learning more information about owls. Such as where they live, what they eat and what they look like.
