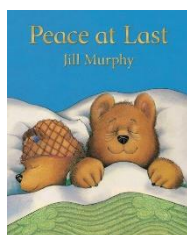

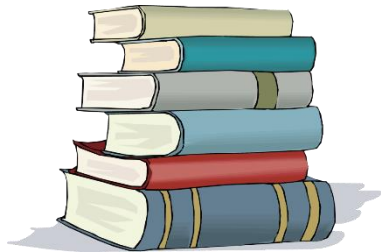
You can help your child to continue their learning at home by:
