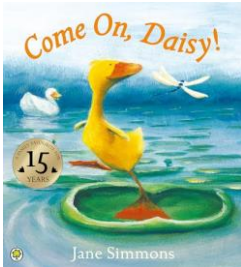


Friday 21st March 2025

Dear Parents and carers,

We are at the end of another wonderful week in Acorn Nursery. The children have all had a busy time learning and exploring new activities including;

- Holding a real life chick!
- Learning all about the lifecycle of a duck. From egg, to hatchling, to duckling, to duck.
