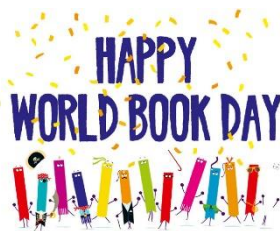
Dear Parents and carers,

We have had a fantastic first week back after half term the children have all been very engaged in all of the new activities in the nursery. They have particularly enjoyed learning in the vets, which has been set up them, continuing our topic about animals. This week we have been;

- Learning what a vet is and what they do.
- Learning new language such as appointment, unwell, medicine, waiting room, stethoscope and bandage.
- Learning about how to have healthy bodies and look after our hearts by doing exercise with Jigsaw Jenie.
- Continuing to learn how to rhyme by reading rhyming poems, playing rhyming games and making silly soup!
- Continuing to explore numbers 1-3 by reading stories such as goldilocks and the 3 bears and counting out 3 objects from a larger group.
- Practicing writing our names, remembering to hold the pen with our pinching fingers.



Next week we will be celebrating Pancake Day. The children will have the opportunity to make and taste pancakes on Wednesday 5th March. Please let a member of staff know if your child should not take part in this activity due to allergies.



World book day is on Thursday 6th March. Children may come into school dressed as their favourite book character on this day.

You can help your child to continue their learning at home by:

- Drawing attention to rhyming words you hear in stories and songs.
- Looking out for numbers 1,2,3 when you are out and about. At the shops, on cars, on buses, on your front door. Ask your child to point to numbers as they see them. Can they show you that many fingers? Ask your child if they can get you 1, 2 or 3 items e.g. can you bring me 1 teddy, 2 cars, 3 building blocks.
